Local chapters of Women Empowered, the company's largest ERG with more than 2,700 members in 43 states and seventeen countries, continues to grow. With membership increasing by approximately 35 percent in the past year, the company recently launched a chapter in India in which several hundred employees joined on the day of the launch. Women Empowered chapters are hosting development opportunities for members and employees through "Lunch & Learn" events. Attendees will hear presentations titled Why Stay?, Breaking the Rules and Believe, Do, Succeed. Guest speakers include leaders from some of today's best-known companies, including Bechtel, Blue Origin, MIT Media Lab, Shell and others.

During the month-long celebration, CenturyLink employees will be encouraged to show their support of women in the workplace by posting pictures online using the hashtags **#EachForEqual** and **#CTLInclusion**.
