"From day one, my Lumen management team and I worked together to develop the best solution for communicating with my co-workers and customers," Eric says. Lumen also provides ASL interpreters for training sessions to make sure I get the full benefit of the training."

The mission of FRIENDS is to bring awareness to the different forms of disabilities, provide education and resources, and lend a helping hand to others who need a friend.
